Catlins Medical Centre -

March 2025

Well here we are well into 2025 and the sun has remembered where we are, so that is great.

We thought we had 2025 covered with locums but unfortunately Dr Takla Gardey has decided that she is burnt out and wants to have some time for herself so will not be returning to the Catlins Medical Centre.

This left us in a bit of a quandary, but we have been able to secure locums until the end of August and are still working on the remainder of the year.

Dr Claudia Mosavi will be returning for regular 3 week blocks during the year along with Dr Gill Penno and Dr Hilkka Sheffield who are covering other blocks, both who have been here previously and are happy to return.

We are continuing to look for a permanent GP but there is a huge shortage of these professionals, so it is just not an easy fix.

In the meantime, we are very fortunate that we are able to secure Locums to keep the practice running.

While this does make it a bit hard for patients, some finding it difficult seeing different doctors, we do try to provide a continuity of care, and we have 3 outstanding nurses who are happy to help with patients concerns. We do thank our patients for their understanding

Our Administration team do try to accommodate patient requests as best they can, so please understand if you can't always get an appointment on the day you request.

Please allow a minimum of 24 hours for repeat prescriptions as these have to be created by the doctor between patients so may not always be done on the day requested.

We now have a patient portal, where you can order repeat prescriptions, make an appointment with a nurse and also check your results once they have been viewed by a doctor.
